

'Beyond Growth 'Conference 2023

Post-Conference Declaration

Brussels, 17th May 2023

At the close of the Beyond Growth Conference 2023, we the participants are united in the view that:

The relentless pursuit of GDP growth has created a global economic system that is fragile, vulnerable to shocks, and which both fails to deliver human well-being and is ecologically unsustainable. It is urgent and imperative that this system change.

We therefore call upon the European Commission, the European Parliament and the Member States to commit to:

1. Replacing GDP growth with human well-being and ecological sustainability as the overarching objectives of all EU policy-making and external action;
2. Redefining the purpose of our economic system as being to deliver human well-being and ecological sustainability;
3. Harnessing the available expertise to develop and adopt alternative indicators to GDP that track progress towards the objectives of human well-being and ecological sustainability, and using macroeconomic modelling to ensure respect for planetary boundaries and the improvement of social well-being.
4. Aligning all EU policy-making and external action with the scientific fact that infinite growth on a finite planet is impossible;
5. Pluralising EU economic thinking and beginning work towards a "post-growth" world that embraces sufficiency, equality and economic democracy;
6. Developing a new strategy, building on the groundwork of the EU Green Deal, to set the pathway to a "post-growth" world in which our economy and society thrive whilst operating within the established planetary limits.
7. Using its influence on the global stage to help end patterns of economic colonialism and create space for new economic models that achieve human well-being and ecological sustainability worldwide.
